Welcome back everyone to a term filled with more exciting Physical Education activities.

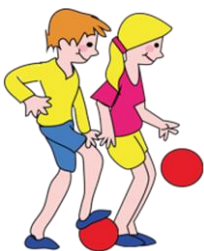
We are currently participating in a 4-week gymnastics block which will be lots of fun learning some new skills.
