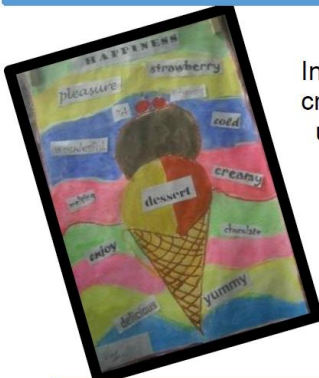


Miss Skouroumounis/Mrs Jachmann's Year 4/5 Class

Integrating Art into all areas of the curriculum has been a great way to learn new Art techniques. Our room has a subscription to a website called 'Artventure'. We regularly use this site as Kirsty, the artist, demonstrates how to go about drawing and painting using a variety of techniques and mediums.



During Book Week last term, we painted these drawings for the theme, 'Escape to Everywhere'. We used oil pastels and paint.



In Literacy, we were looking at shape poems and created a poem about ice-creams. This work also used crayons and paint.

The Art focus for this lesson was making paint bleed and drawing silhouettes. We used black textas, and paint.



In Maths, we are learning about fractions. We were given the task of creating a picture using the fraction kits and labelling the fractions of each piece used.



In Health we are looking at the human body and movement. Using sketching techniques and charcoal, we drew skeletons and in preparation for PE week, we created drawings of people jumping.



For this Art work, we looked at one-point perspective and created our pieces using pencils and textas.

At the moment, we are working on painting plates with special ceramic paint. Our plates will be fired in a kiln ready for use at home. We are all enjoying the different skills and techniques we are learning each week.
